



Single Point Sling Attachment Installation Procedure

Thank you for purchasing our products. All of our products are 100% designed and made in the USA.

Please read instructions completely prior to installation.

1. Prior to servicing your firearm, make sure that the action is open and it is un-loaded and that you follow all standard firearms safe handling procedures.
2. Our single point sling attachment (SPSA) is designed to replace one of the stock frame pins on your KSG. Determine which pin you would like to replace and remove and store the frame pin for future use. See figure 1.
3. Unscrew the end of the SPSA opposite the o-ring. You may need to use one or both of the frame pins to assist in the initial dis-assembly. Do not clean the threads on the eye or shaft, they are coated with loctite to assure positive retention after assembly. See figure 2.
4. The fixed end of the SPSA with the o-ring is intended to be inserted from the side of the KSG which will have the least amount of usage with a sling attached. See figure 3.
5. Screw on the threaded eye to the shaft and tighten using the other frame pin and the clip of your single point sling. See figure 4.

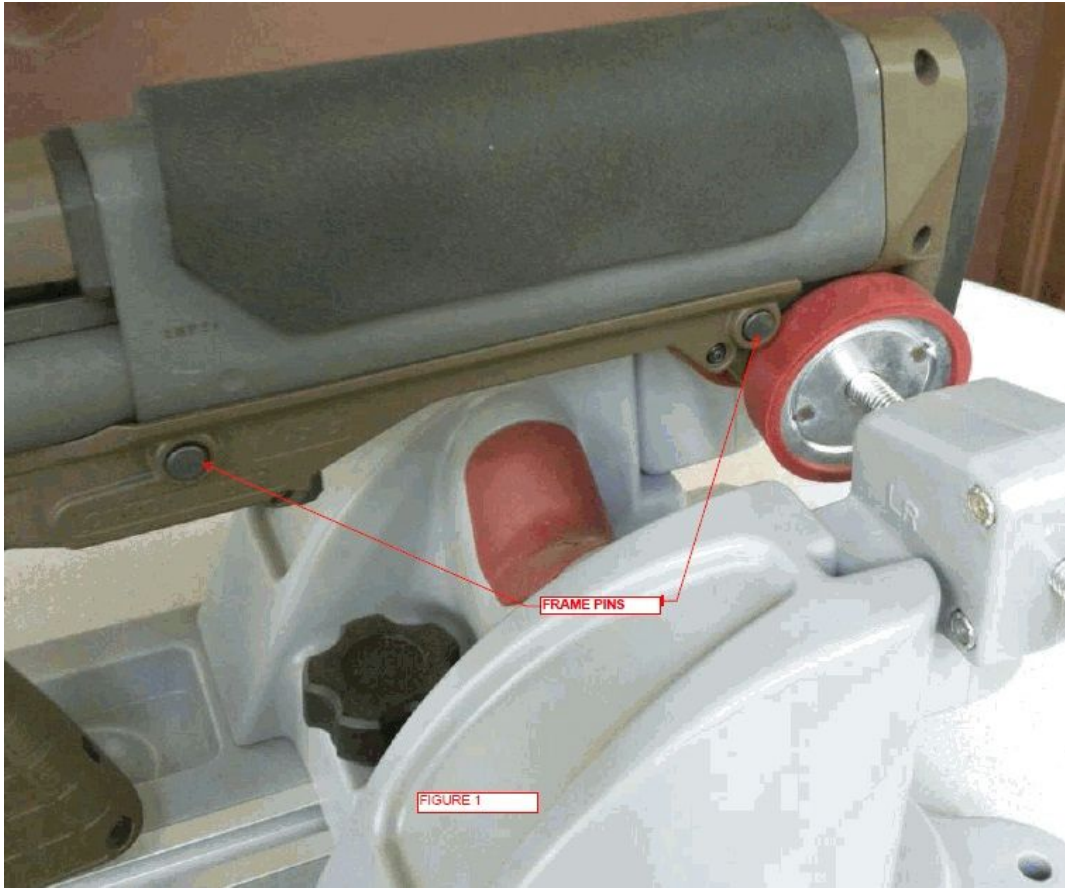
